

Rules

Early Bird Deadline is November 1st, 2022

Deadline for registration is November 16th, 2022

Competitors must have their competitor's number at least one hour before their event and report to the deck captain 45 minutes before their round.

Changes must be made before the event starts. Any last-minute changes must be known and approved by the organizer before the event starts.

Responsibility

The organizer will not be responsible for loss or theft of articles left in changing rooms, ballroom, or hotel rooms. Neither will the organizer be held liable for injuries sustained by competitors, spectators, staff, officials, vendors and volunteers or anybody attending the event.

Everyone attends at their own risk. The organizer reserves the right to reject any entry.

PRO-AM CANCELLATION: A cancellation made after November 16th, 2022, will be processed after the event. A cancellation fee \$150 will be charged. No refunds on admission tickets.

In the instance where three (3) couples or less are competing in a category, the cash prize will be reduced by one half.

PROFESSIONAL: Professional competitors must be registered for 2022 with CDF (www.canadiandancesportfederation.ca)

AMATEUR: All "Amateur" competition is sanctioned by NDCC (National Dance Council of Canada). Dress code is available on NDCC web site.

All Canadian amateur competitors **MUST** be registered at NDCC.

PRO-AM: Pro-Am students do not need to be registered with any association.

There will be **No Substituting** of a student for another student. Only registered student may participate in the event.

No solo routine should exceed three (3) minutes. To be eligible for a championship, the student must have a minimum of 10 single dances in the same category.

Formations: Must be comprised of THREE (3) or more couples. Maximum duration per dance is limited to two and a half (2.5) minutes for a single dance and three (3) minutes for a medley.

Top Teacher Prizes

- 1st place \$4000 minimum 400 entries
- 2nd place \$3000 minimum 300 entries
- 3rd place \$2000 minimum 200 entries
- 4th place \$1000 minimum 150 3ntries
- 5th place \$500 minimum 100 entries
- 6th place \$250 minimum 80 entries

Teachers must have the minimum number of entries that corresponds with the prize money. "Sharing" students does not award point to all teachers. To qualify, entries must be received by deadline and paid in full. Proficiency and Student/Student entries do not qualify towards Top Teacher points accumulation.
